

IMMEDIATE LOAD PATIENT INFORMATION

You are coming in to have implants placed in either one or both of your jaws and teeth placed onto those implants on the same day.

This is a time consuming procedure that will take either half a day for one jaw or a full day for both jaws.

During this time there will be natural breaks for resting due to the amount of time required in the laboratory to construct the teeth that will be fixed onto the implants.



Please be aware of the following:

1. It is important that you have either lunch or breakfast and hydrate well before coming for surgery.
2. At times we will be working in the laboratory and you may want to bring a book to read, crossword to do, film to watch or music to listen to (or you can just rest and doze!)
3. You will have a staff member with you at all times.
4. You will have a room to yourself the whole time you are here.
5. If you need a break for the toilet please just ask and we can stop working on you.
6. If you are having a full mouth procedure (both jaws) please bring some soft snacks as you may well get hungry: yogurt, protein drinks and soft or mashed food are ideal.
